UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 1. East Side of Lower Pine Lake Road Chairman Johnson welcomed them back. Chairman Johnson informed what has been going on since the last board meeting. The Attorneys will meet with the Town Board and look at the road. Dennis O'Hearn has been looking for metal marker's that would show the lay out of the road. Will be put on next month's agenda.
- 2. Driveway Ordinance Talked about who should issue the driveway permits. Supervisor Johnson suggested that before we adopt the new driveway ordinance we should have the Plan Commission Committee look over and study the ordinance. John Bonneprise asked that the Town of Alden give Polk County Highway Department a copy of the ordinance and also work with the County.
- 3. Dog Ordinance Suggested that we advertise for the position of a Dog Warden. We will have a hearing prior to our next board meeting. Dog Ordinance will be put on next month's agenda.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Ed Flanum Certified Survey Map Concept Ed Flanum presented before the Town Board a proposal of six lots for the 80 acres of the Fowler property. <u>Voice Motion by Supervisor Anderson to approve the Certified Survey Map. The motion failed for lack of a second.</u> Asked to be put on next month's agenda.
- 2. Sheriff Ann Hraychuck Will Be Attending Sheriff Ann Hraychuck talked about the dog problem in Polk County. She also talked about raising money for all of Polk County for a humane or animal control officer. The County is going to first educate the public. Second, send out a uniform dog license fee form throughout the county. They will keep us posted on the progress.
- 3. Statutory Planning Commission -
 - a) Committee Report Gary Dado gave a report about their last meeting. Next meeting will October 17, 2002
 - b) Grant Application State of Wisconsin has budgeted three and one half million dollars for the planning process. Best way to go about getting this grant is to team up with other town and villages. The deadline is November 1, 2002.

- 185th is set to be paved.
